The Chairman reported that he with the
Clerk & several members of the Board
met the assistant Engineer & the District
Engineer of the F. V. Ry Co at Colham
Dundee on the 21st November last
and inspected the works of the Company
and received an explanation of
what was intended to be done.

It was ordered that, without prejudice
to any legal question which might
arise ~~the~~ ^{the} Company in the future, the
Company be allowed to pump the
water from the new Ballast pit
into the north drain under an
agreement similar to the hitherto
existing agreement in regard to the
old Ballast pit provided that the Company
highlight & make good the Bank
of the Board situated in the north

of South sides of Lollham Ditches
to the satisfaction of the Surveyor
of the Board to prevent as far as
possible flooding of the land both
on the Mancey & the Deepstone sides
of the Railway

Mr Williams applied in behalf of

the Deeping lock & he was ordered to
make the payment.
