The question of the drain at Chinton was
discussed and the sub-committee reported
their visit. Mr. Stange pointed out that it
was illegal to allow any sewage to be
admitted to the boards drains. After a

long discussion Mr. Heaverson proposed
that the Council be asked to relay
the drain they piped at the old level
making them inlet into the boards drain
approximately 10 1/2 in higher. This to
be done to the satisfaction of the Board
Surveyor. This was recorded by Mr.

S. Vespelle & carried - Mr. Stange disapproved
Mr. Stanges proposals were further considered
and he suggested that the Surveyor
should report whether it was possible
to drain the water down by gravitation
into an existing drain adjacent

to the Crowland Bank. It was decided
that the surveyor should report accordingly.
