occupiers rate


(b) As to the North Fen District

- (4) That the purposes for which the rates
are to be made are
- (a) to meet the cost of administration
 - (b) to meet the cost of maintenance
 - (c) to meet the cost of improvement
of existing work or the cost of
new work.
 - (d) to meet expenditure incurred before
the passing of the Land Drainage
Act 1930.
- (5) That the period for which the rates
are to be made be from 1st April 1933
to 31st March 1934.

Mr Hadman and carried that notice of the rates
be advertised one insertion in Peterborough Standard.






