An Innovation Centre has been created at The Forge by creating access to and renovating the space in the loft. The Centre has a number of purposes: it provides space for archive material and for research and also for 3D printing.



We offer 3D Printing, 3D Scanning and 3D Pen. The equipment is key to the Virtual Craft Simulation project that is being developed in partnership with the University of Lincoln. The project aims to revive the Blacksmith craft, making it accessible to young people, by using 21st century technology.
