PLEASE NOTE-

Household numbers were simply allocated by enumerators; they were NOT house numbers, which barely existed at the time.

The data refers to the built up area i.e. the zone of more or less continuous building shown on the map.

SECTION A

Please Note-

The occupations shown are of heads of households only. They are as complete as possible on pages 1-7, but on pages 8-11 only people of some substance are listed. They were named separately in the local directories of 1849 and 1856, indicating that they had set up in business on their own account.

The actual census date was 30th March 1851, the town being divided up into areas known as enumeration districts, each of which was supposed to cover about 100 households. An enumerator was appointed to each of these districts and was responsible for handing out, checking and collecting the householders' schedules. He then had to copy the details into an enumerator's book, which was sent to the Registrar. Much further checking and revision then took place before the final census information was published. The total cost of the work in Spalding in 1851 came to £95/3/0.

Street names and spelling are as used in the census e.g. Holbech Road, St. Thomas's Road was then called Thomazine Road, Swan Street was Deadman's Lane and Water Lane Carey's Lane.

SECTION B

Please Note-

The data in this section is obtained from the built up area of Spalding, i.e. the area of more or less continuous settlement. Most of it is shown on the map at the end of Section C, except for outlying parts of Bourn Road, London Road and Holbech Road.

The table of sons and daughters living with parents gives a rough guide to family size, but cannot include children who have died or left home. The underlined numbers at the top of the table indicate the actual numbers of sons and daughters in the parental home at the time of the census. Thus in Albion St there were 3 families with only one child, 2 with two, 4 with three, and so on.

In all cases in this section the data is dealt with on a street basis, although sometimes, mainly for convenience in presentation, two or more streets are grouped together. Where this occurs only streets of a like nature are combined.

Manufacturing, which was the most important sector, covered a very wide variety of activities, mainly carried out by individuals in their own homes or small groups in appropriate premises. There was no large scale factory industry.

Industrial service mainly involved labourers who were ready to turn their hands to work in many of the industries of the town.

The population structure table shows the number of males and females in the 5-year age groups in the various streets of the town. However, all those aged 70 or more were grouped together, owing to restriction of space on the sheets. The final column T shows the total number of males and females in each street.

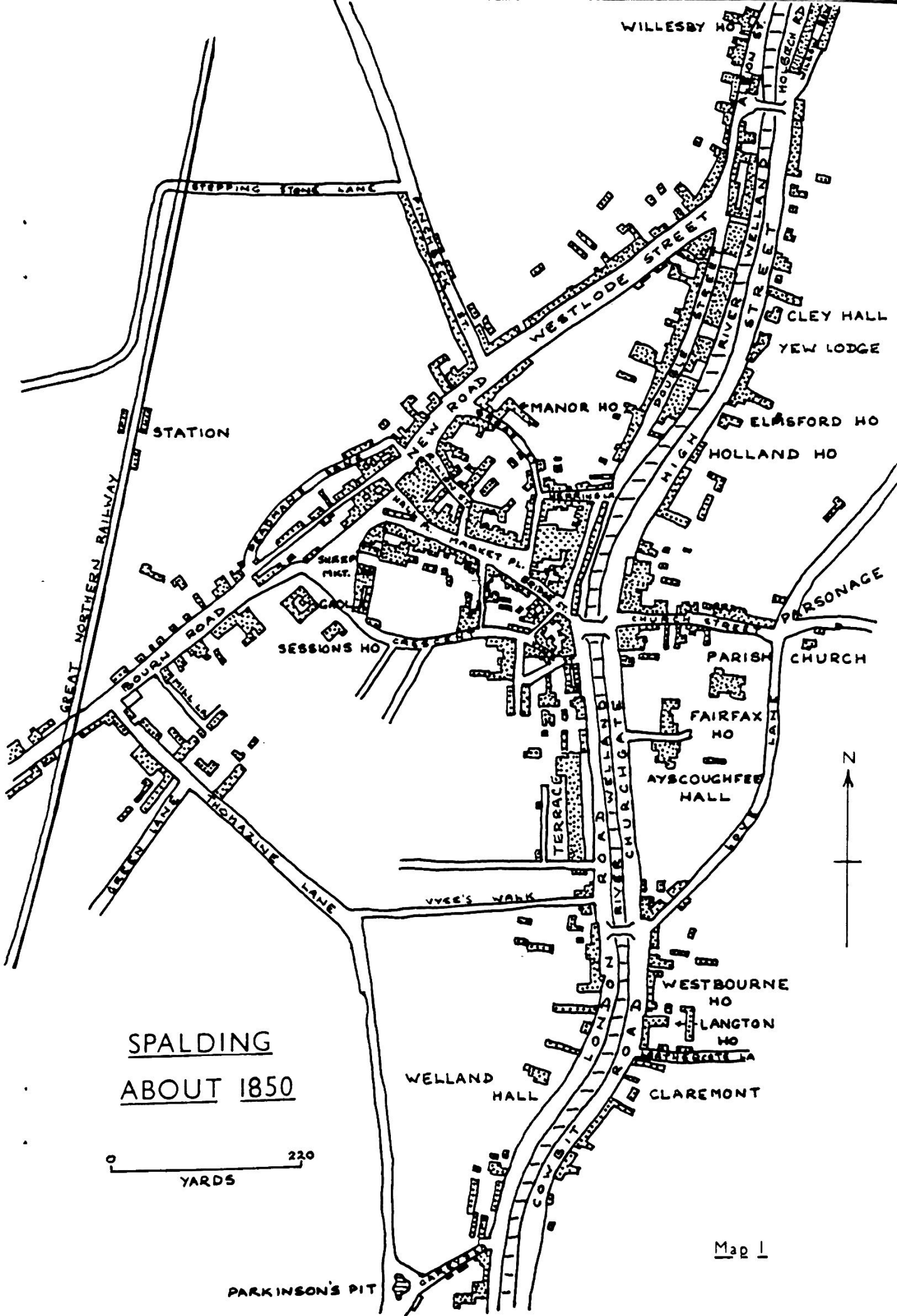
